Rules & Regulations

Players: Players must be enrolled in the grade in which they are participating. However, it is permissible to play up. For example, a 5th grader may play on a 6th grade team, but a 6th grader may not play on a 5th grade team

Team Composition: Teams may be composed of players from anywhere, as long as they meet the grade division requirements.

Playing Rules

Game Length: Games shall be two 18-minute running time halves, with the last two minutes of each half being stop time on every whistle. If one team is ahead by 20 or more points in the second half, the clock will not stop. In the event that games fall too far behind schedule, we reserve the right to eliminate the two-minute stop time at the end of the first and second halves.

Half Time: Half time not to exceed five minutes. We reserve the right to reduce or eliminate the half time should games fall too far behind.

Time outs: Each team will be awarded two time outs per half, One full and one 30 second time outs. Unused time outs cannot be carried over to the second half; Each team will be given one additional time out for the first overtime period.

Overtime Periods: If a game is tied at the end of regulation time, a two minute STOP time overtime period shall be played, If the score is still tied at the end of the over time period, the teams will play a sudden death period (with no time on the clock). The first team to score shall be declared the winner.

Warm-ups: Each team will be given a minimum of three minutes to warm up prior to tip-off. More time will be allowed whenever possible.

Start Time: Because there are so many teams participating in our tournament, we are operating on a very tight schedule. Therefore, game time is forfeit time. The site supervisor will make the final decision on game forfeitures. The site supervisor will assess each individual situation on its own merit prior to declaring a forfeit.

Game Balls: Game balls will be provided for each game, Practice balls - Teams must provide their own practice balls.

Uniforms: Jersey tops must be of identical color and should be numbered on the front and back.

Locker rooms: Locker rooms will be available but they will not be locked or supervised, so please don't leave any valuables in the locker rooms. The tournament will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

First Aid: Teams are responsible for supplying and administering their own first aid... Ice is available at each gym.

General Rules

A. Bonus shots shall be awarded on the 7th team foul, and the double bonus will be shot on the 10th team foul per half.

B. Teams may not use a full court press or play a Zone defense in the 4th and 5th grade divisions, and cannot press in all other divisions if they are ahead by 20 or more points. The penalty for each violation of this rule shall be a technical foul. Technical fouls will NOT be shot; they will be an automatic 2 points and the ball out of bounds.

C. Any player, coach or spectator ejected from a contest for flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct shall be ejected for the remainder of that game and the following game. Some examples of flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct include but are not limited to fighting, repeated verbal abuse, intentional actions that inflict or intend to inflict bodily harm, cheating (such as use of a declared ineligible player), repeated use of profane language, etc. We reserve the right to issue more severe disciplinary action if deemed appropriate.

D. The three point shot is in effect for all levels of play

Officials: Two officials will be assigned to each game.

Awards: Individual trophies will be awarded to each team member (**maximum of 10 per team**) on the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 5th place teams in the 8 team brackets... 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams in the 6 team pools... and 1st and 2nd place in the 4 and 5 team pools.
