Advisory Committee
Duties**

I. Advisory Committee Composition

- a. The Advisory Committee Members shall be chosen by the Directors of the NDTCN.
- b. Terms shall be a renewable 3 year term
- c. An Advisory Committee member choosing to terminate their position on the NDTCN Advisory Committee should do so in writing to the President of the Teacher Center Network

II. Meetings

- a. The Advisory Committee will meet at the call of the President or as needed.
- b. The President of the Teacher Center Network shall notify members of the Advisory Committee as to date, time, and location of all meetings.
- c. The members of the Advisory Committee shall have the right to voice concerns at Network Meetings but my only vote upon actions presented by the Advisory Board.
- d. The DPI Liaison shall be granted voting rights at Network Meetings.
- e. Members of the Advisory Committee must attend a minimum of one meeting of the NDTCN per calendar year.

II. Duties

- a. To advise the Network
- b. To recommend action to be instituted toward Teacher Centers which do not comply with the minimum funding guidelines of the Network.
- c. Recommended action should be brought before the Teacher Center Network Directors and voted upon by the Network Directors and the Advisory Committee in attendance at the Network meeting.
- d. Approval of any action must be by majority of those voting.
